**Eligibility:** You must be a 2024 graduate from Canton, Plymouth, Salem, or Starkweather High School. You must declare your intent to become an educator in a public school and explain why. Your application must include the following:

**1. Personal resume that includes:**

- Co-curricular activities
- Experience working with children
- Transcript of grades
- ACT or SAT scores
- College you plan to attend

**2. Two letters of recommendation:**

- One should be from a P-CCS teacher/counselor
- One should be from an adult who knows you in a capacity beyond the classroom.
- Your relationship with this person must be explained in the letter.

**3. A one page typed essay that addresses the following topics:**

- a. What teacher(s) in Plymouth-Canton Community Schools had the biggest influence on you while you were a student? What qualities did this teacher possess?
- b. Which of these qualities do you have?
- c. What experiences have you had that demonstrate these qualities?
- d. What do you plan to teach? (grade level and subject area)
