1. Personal resume that includes:

Co-curricular activities
Experience working with children
Transcript of grades
ACT or SAT scores
College you plan to attend

2. Two letters of recommendation:

One should be from a P-CCS teacher/counselor

One should be from an adult who knows you in a capacity beyond the classroom. Your relationship with this person must be explained in the letter.

- 3. A one page typed essay that addresses the following topics:
 - a. What teacher(s) in Plymouth-Canton Community Schools had the biggest influence on you while you were a student? What qualities did this teacher possess?
 - b. Which of these qualities do you have?
 - c. What experiences have you had that demonstrate these qualities?
 - d. What do you plan to teach? (grade level and subject area)
